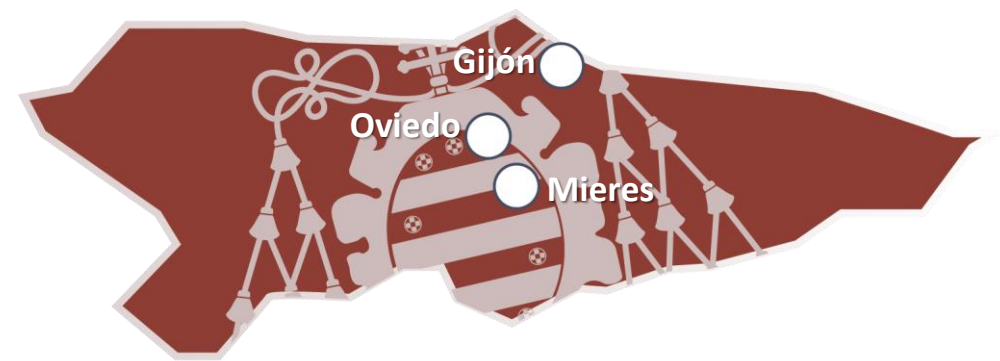

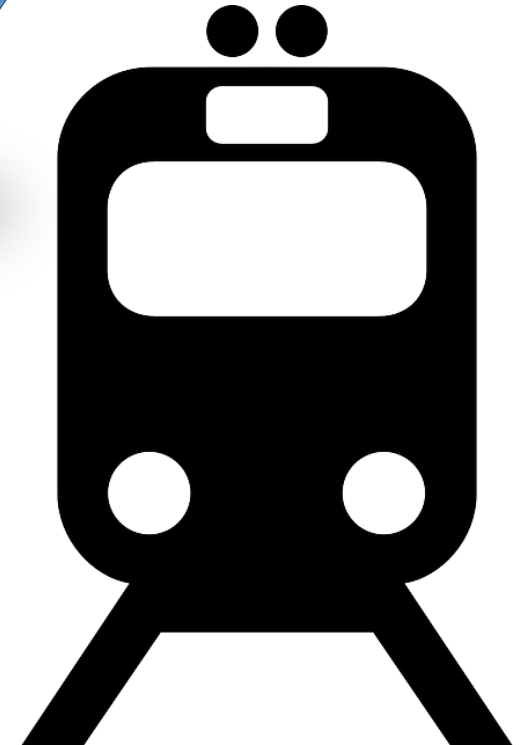
The public transport network in Asturias allows passengers to enjoy a wide range of timetables and options for getting around the region.

Virtual Campus



Once the enrolment has been formalized at the secretariat of the student's faculty/school or at the Office of International Relations (ORI - Gijón), the international student will be provided with an institutional e-mail address and a user pin code to access **the University Intranet** and, among other services, the **Virtual Campus**, where information on the classes registered can be found.

University Card



Students can apply for a student card, which will give them access to the different services of the University of Oviedo (libraries, sports services, transport discounts, etc.). You can obtain the card at one of the **university registers** between 9:00 and 14:00.

Administrative Process

Changes in the length of the stay

To extend or reduce the agreed-upon period of stay, favorable reports must be obtained from the professors overseeing the exchange agreement at both the sending and receiving universities. These reports must be submitted before the originally agreed-upon period concludes, at the Administrative Unit of the student's faculty and the Office for International Relations.

Changes to the Learning Agreement

Any changes to the learning agreement must be validated by the professors responsible for the exchange agreement in both the sending and receiving universities. Once signed by all parties, the documents must be submitted to the administrative unit of the faculty in which the student is registered.

Cancellation of classes

The cancellation of classes that appear in the final learning agreement does not grant students the right to register for new classes as replacements. Students are only permitted to cancel their registration for a course if they have not yet completed the final examination for that particular course. Regardless, students seeking to cancel their course registration must obtain approval from the professors responsible for the exchange agreement at both the sending and receiving universities. The favorable reports supporting these changes will then be presented at the administrative unit of the faculty in which the student is registered.

Application deadline: 28 April 2024 (annual and second-semester subjects)

Residence Permit Formalities in Spain

Citizens from EU countries, including Norway, Iceland, Liechtenstein and Switzerland

The formalities for obtaining a residence permit in Spain vary depending on the length of stay.

- **For stays of less than 3 months:**

Applicants only need to be in possession of a valid passport or identity card.

- **For stays longer than 3 months:**

If applicants do not have a foreigner identity number (NIE), they are required to apply for registration as an EU resident at the Office for Foreigners of the Police Station nearest to their official address in Spain if they are in the country, or at the Consular Office if they are outside of Spain.

Required documentation:

- Valid passport or identity document.
- Completed application form (form EX18) available at ([18-Certificado residencia comunitaria.pdf \(inclusion.gob.es\)](#)).
- Proof of payment using form 790, code 012 (applicable if NIE is not available). Download the form at [Tasa790_012 \(policia.gob.es\)](#).
- Certificate of census registration (essential to cancel when the stay ends) or a direct debit receipt.

Entry and Residence Formalisation in Spain

Citizens from non-EU countries, including the United Kingdom

- **Entry:**

Documentation:

- Valid passport with the entry stamp or control mark made at the border post.
- Documents accrediting be undertaking studies or research at the University.
- Proof of sufficient means of subsistence for the intended stay in Spain or the ability to legally obtain such means if there is no visa or residence card for studies.
- Visa, if applicable.
- Medical insurance

- **Extension of stay:**

To extend the stay, it is necessary to apply for an extension

Documentation:

- The same documents as the entry requirements.
- Completed application form (form EX00) available at [00-Formulario_estancia.pdf \(inclusion.gob.es\)](#).
- Proof of payment using form 790, code 012 [00-Formulario_estancia.pdf \(inclusion.gob.es\)](#).
- Guarantees of return to the country of origin.
- Travel assistance insurance.

Foreigner's Identity Number (NIE or TIE)

Applicants staying for more than six months

Upon arriving in Spain, it is necessary to apply for the Foreigner's Identity Number (NIE or TIE) if the intended stay is longer than six months.

- **Application:**

Visit the Office for Foreigners of the Police Station closest to your residence.

- **Documentation:**

- Foreigner's Identity Card (TIE) application form (form EX17) available at [17-Formulario TIE.pdf \(inclusion.gob.es\)](#).
- Proof of payment using form 790, code 012, available at [Tasa790 012 \(policia.gob.es\)](#).
- Valid passport or identity document.
- Certificate of census registration (essential to cancel when the stay ends) or a direct debit receipt.

Foreigner's Identity Number (NIE or TIE)

Other citizens

This section is relevant for applicants who are not covered in the previous category or individuals who, for various reasons, need to apply for a Foreigner's Identification Number (NIE or TIE).

- **Application:**

Visit the Directorate-General of the Police or the Office for Foreigners of the Police Station closest to your residence. If you are not within Spanish territory, apply at the General Commissariat of Foreigners and Borders through the Consular Offices of Spain abroad.

- **Documentation:**

- Foreigner's Identity Card (TIE) application form (form EX15) available at [15-Formulario NIE y certificados.pdf \(inclusion.gob.es\)](#).
- Proof of payment using form 790, code 012, available at [Tasa790 012 \(policia.gob.es\)](#).
- Valid passport or identity document.
- Certificate of census registration (essential to cancel when the stay ends) or a direct debit receipt.

Application for a Health Insurance Card



Applicants are required to visit the administrative unit of the health centre or consultancy that corresponds to their usual place of residence





- **Documentation** (in general):

Mobility for international students


The University of Oviedo receives more than a thousand foreign students every year. It is a sought-after destination and highly valued by international students thanks to the academic prestige enjoyed by the academic institution and its privileged location in a setting such as the Principality of Asturias.

To facilitate the legal and academic procedures as much as possible and to help foreign students in their adaptation process, the University of Oviedo offers them a network of services and advice that will allow them to resolve their doubts quickly.

The International Attention Office offers the necessary information and support to carry out all the academic procedures and formalities that facilitate the adaptation of the university student

Through the International Student Services Office you will get all the information and support necessary to complete the legal and academic procedures and to carry out essential formalities, such as opening a bank account or studying the different accommodation options. Prospective students of the University of Oviedo will be able to plan their trip in advance and have all the information they need before arriving in Asturias.

Help in the first weeks of their stay will also come from their fellow students. The a-dUO programme puts the new student in contact with a Spanish student from the same campus, who will orient and guide them during their first weeks in Asturias.
