When foreign students talk about people in Britain, they often do so in terms of stereotypes. The Englishman is thought to be a man in a bowler hat drinking tea, for example. The Scot, on the other hand, wears a skirt and carries a bottle of whisky everywhere. Such simplifications occur whenever people refer to the inhabitants of other countries. They are unlikely to be true of individuals, although there *are* such things as national and regional characteristics that can be identified. Within England itself, for instance, the differences between North and South are always a source of argument. To a Southerner, Northerners are uncultured barbarians with strong accents. Northerners, on the other hand, think Londoners, in particular, are lazy, selfish and insincere.

While rivalries exist between different regions of a country and the inhabitants themselves even enjoy them, outsiders are usually warned not to take part. It is a fact that in some places national and regional characteristics are a risky topic in conversation.
