## TEXTO A: Tea in Britain

1. Originally from China, tea got to Europe in the mid 17th century via Venice into the British Isles thanks to Portuguese ships, and Portuguese and Dutch traders. Tea was introduced in England through the London coffee houses. Thomas Garway, one of the first merchants to offer tea, advertised it as particularly healthy for the body.
2. Tavern owners and the government were afraid of the popularity of tea in Britain. On the one hand, tavern owners saw a decrease in beer and gin sales; on the other hand, the government got a lower income from taxes on the selling of alcohol.
3. Its origin is found in Anna, 7th Duchess of Bedford, who invented the idea of having tea late in the afternoon between lunch time and dinner time. The working classes followed this stylish habit and made it into high tea, their main meal of the day.
4. There is a strong link between the two. In China tea used to be drunk from cups without handles. However, the British habits of drinking tea required good cups with handles, which stimulated the growth of porcelain industry as well as the prosperity of companies such as Wedgwood and Royal Albert.
